## **Fundamental Concepts**

## **FACILITY**

relates to adequate facilities in order to allow arrivals and departures without delay


#### **SAFETY**

relates to the prevention of aircraft, equipment and staff accidents and incidents

## **SECURITY**

relates to the prevention of intentional acts intending to affect planes, infrastructures or people





The **decentralized** model means that security activities are mainly performed by airports under the supervision of the relevant authority
