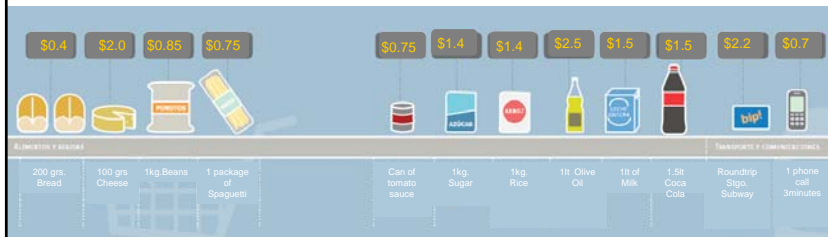

¿What does it mean to be poor in Chile?

\$4.5 USD per day = Poverty
\$3.0 USD per day = Extreme Poverty



MAIN GOAL: To Have Less Than 1% of The Population Living Under **Extreme Poverty by 2014.**

Policy measure

To complement cash transfers with other policies that will enable poor people to get out of poverty by their own.



Chile Oportunidades: Two Stage Conditional Cash Transfer Program

- 1st Stage: **Asignación Social** (Year: April 2011-Dic 2011)

- Cash Transfer composed by:

a) Fixed component

b) Additional component if one of the following conditions is fulfilled:

- Child medical control
- School enrollment
- School attendance
- Women employability

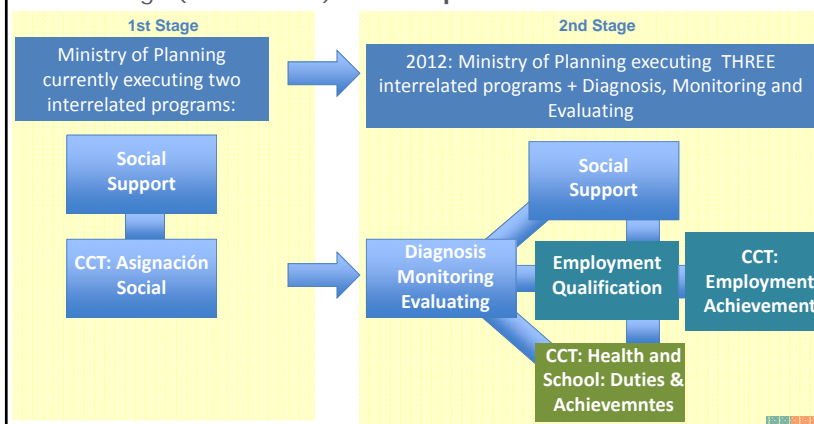

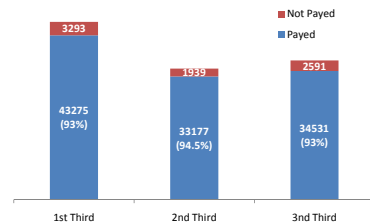

Use Conditional Cash Transfers as an Incentive to Promote Financial Inclusion.

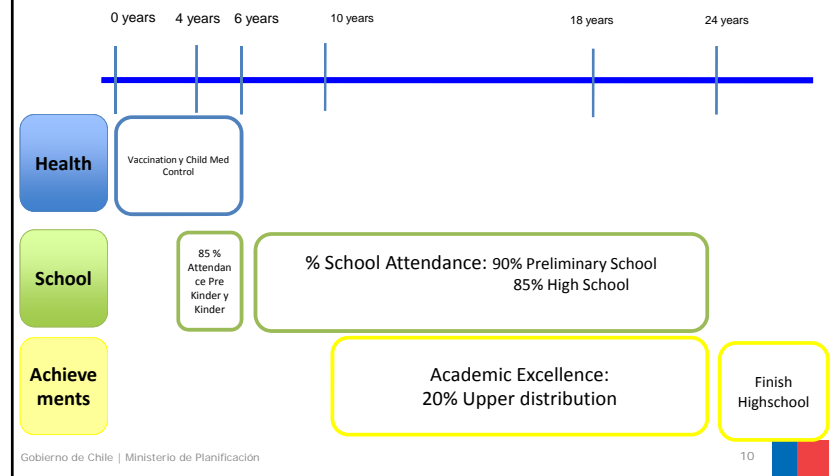
Ministry of Planning has a center role in achieving Financial Inclusion → Coordination of other Stakeholders.
