- "The current Niigata Action Plan on Food Security established at the 2010 ministerial meeting on food security sets forth an excellent starting point to build from."
- "The PPFS will establish both short-term and long term goals each year and the chair of the PPFS with assistance from PPFS members will report on implementation of the APEC Food Security Action

as outlined in the 2010 APEC Ministerial Meeting on Food Security Declaration."







◆ Japan thinks that it is necessary for all the PPFS members to be directly and thoroughly involved in the entire process of working out the Action Plan and Specific PPFS Activities, which are going to be implemented by the members based upon the APEC spirit of cooperation and voluntarism.

More specifically, we, as a memberdriven society, need to work out the Action Plan through the discussion among all the PPFS members, as agreed in the Kazan PPFS Meeting rather than outsourcing its drafting, which is suggested by US Proposal.

The MC drafted and distributed the Action Plan on Sep 11 in line with Summary Record2.

It is necessary to have consultation with PPFS members ahead of finalizing the Action Plan in line with Summary Record<sup>3</sup>.
