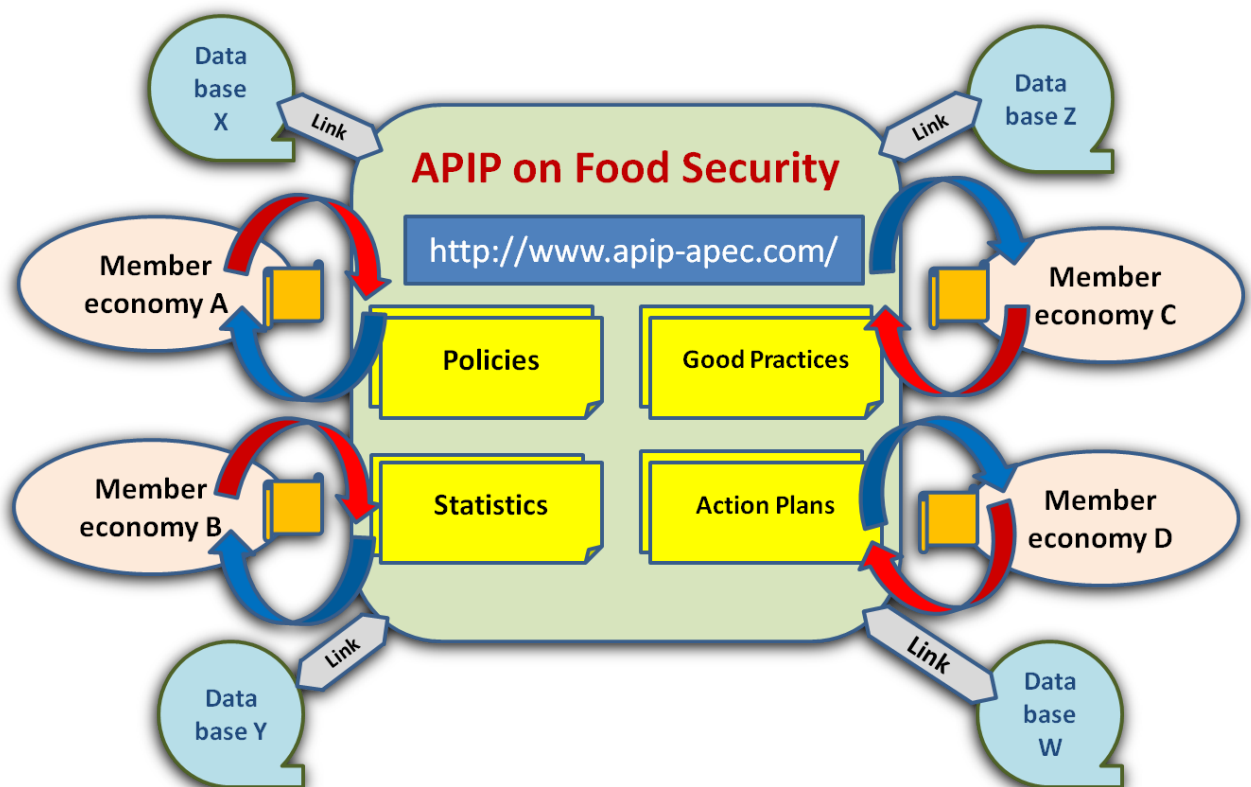
## **Comprehensive Information Platform**
