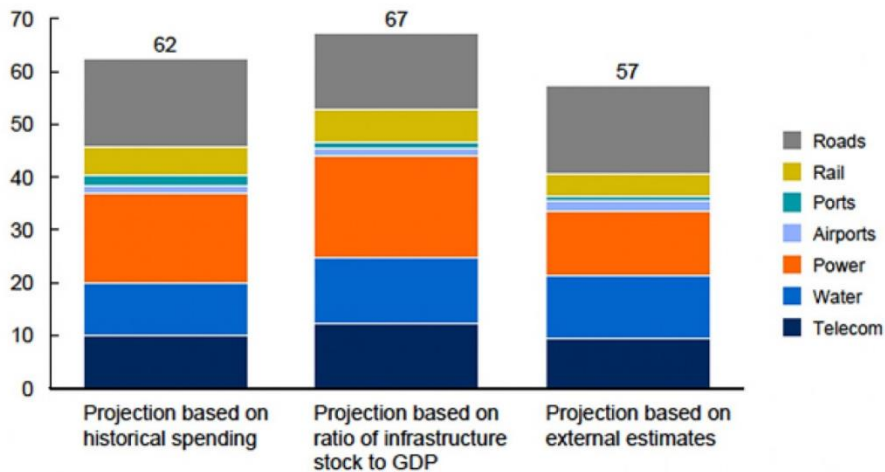


Why IISS?

- Public sector in general does not invest extensively in project preparation, and too often, inconsistently
- Private sector is regularly asked to be involved during the project preparation
- Real need for more projects to be better prepared in a consistent way
- IISS' goal is to raise the quality, consistency and transparency of the public sector's project preparation
- IISS aims to improve the interface with financiers and funders to maximize funding options for the public sector (public, PPP and private)

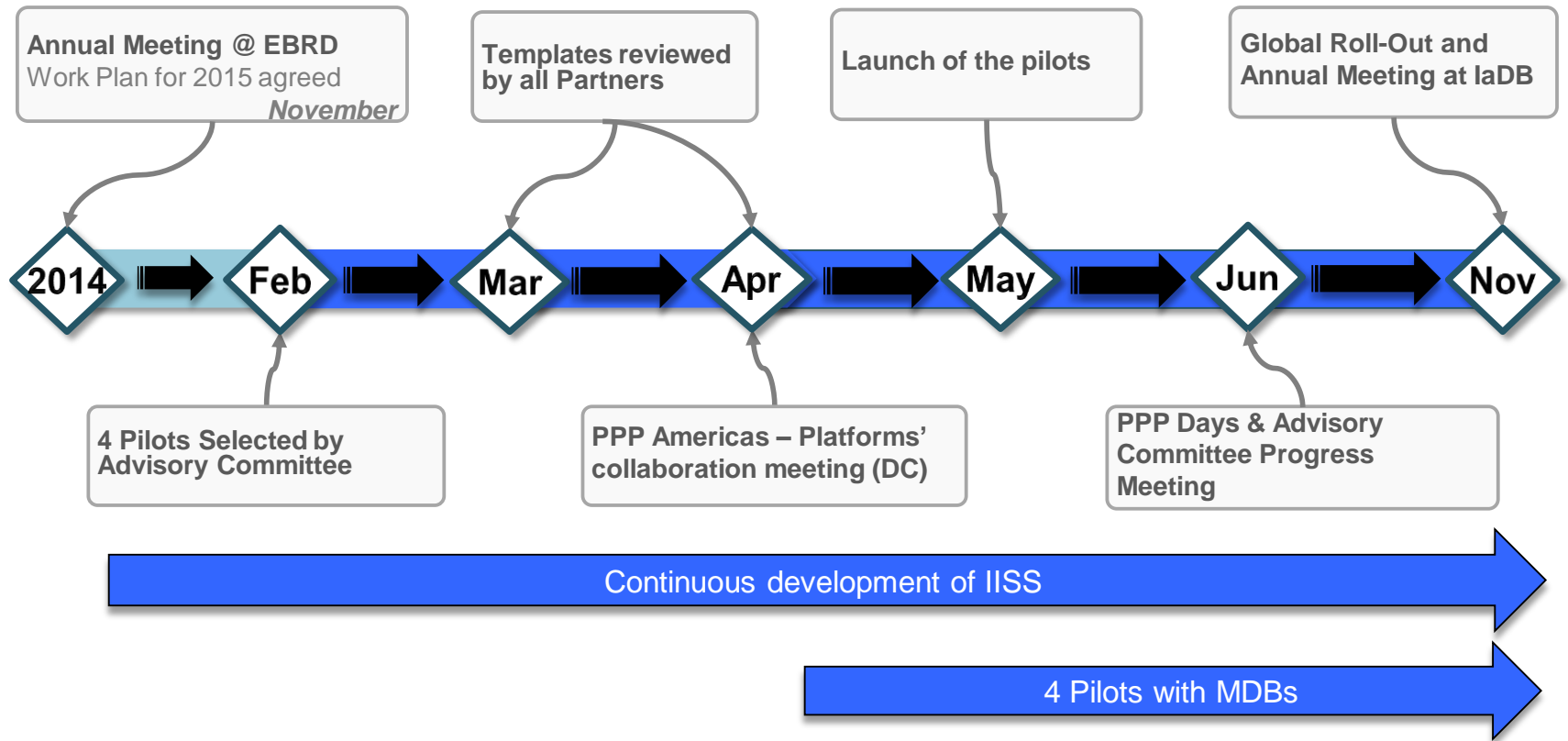
