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What is Inclusive Business?

A business model to the low and middle income people as a solution to improve their income using innovative and systemic approach.

 ADB's definition: Inclusive Business is a "commercially viable companies that offer systemic private sector solution (in scale) to relevant problems of the poor and low income people".



IB in Indonesia-Issues and Challenges

- Lack of understanding of IB
- IB = CSR and or social entrepreneurship
- New concept of business model
- No proven IB model just yet
- Still focus in agribusiness sector



Is IB model suitable for Indonesia?

- Indonesian Government goals and objective-pushes reforms to increase economic growth, pro poor, integrated national development, food security.
- Others business models are worked with the poor BUT do not necessarily generate systemic impact on poverty reduction and inclusion, while IB gives access to financial institution as well as access to market
- IB is a business model using the company's revenue and profit but also using the company's relevance and the social impact it's created, they build a sustainable business for the poor to improve their life standard in systemic and innovative way.





What should be done in Indonesia?

- Start promoting IB concept.
- Make public & government awareness.
- Government support.
- Credible and international/local institution (such as ADB, KADIN, Apindo) assistance.
- Develop an independent IB accreditation agency.
