

Case Study – FSMA

- Food Safety Modernization Act signed January 2011
- Listening sessions followed
- FDA then drafted proposed rules based on the new law, as well as input from public meetings and listening sessions
- FDA then published proposed rules for comment

Case Study – FSMA

- Following the publication of the proposed rules, FDA:
 - Held proposal public meetings, listening sessions, industry roundtables, individual meetings
 - Drafted Supplemental rules
 - Published Supplemental Proposed Rules
- MORE Public meetings, listening sessions, industry roundtables, individual meetings were held after the publication of the Supplemental Proposed Rules
