Capacity Building in Projects

- In 2015, SCE approved a new capacity building policy
 - Capacity building in APEC is defined as: "A process to enable member economies - particularly developing economies - to obtain, share, strengthen, maintain and develop knowledge, abilities, skills and technical know-how to improve their policies and regulations or their institutional structures or processes"
- Budget and Management Committee is examining how to strengthen project focus on capacity building. By 2017, you can expect:
 - Updates to the Guidebook on APEC Projects and project templates
 - Possible changes to the project selection and approval process
