



- Encourage alliances and productive linkages between companies of the PA.







The State with which all Parties to the Pacific Alliance Framework Agreement celebrate and bring into force a binding agreement of high commercial and economic standards that contributes to the achievement of the objectives of the Pacific Alliance Framework Agreement.

On September 2017, PA chief negotiators and chief negotiatiors from Australia, Canada, New Zeland and Singapore will hold their first meeting to agree on the Terms of Reference (TdR) of the negotiation.
