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

Most countries cannot be trusted to engage in fair trade practices


Eroding Social Values



Values that made this country great are disappearing


Society changing too quickly and not in ways that benefit people like me




Trade in Services

(% of GDP)





• Trade in services in PA has grown 70% between 2005-2016.









Figure 3.4. The cost of regulatory heterogeneity for cross-border exports


Figure 4.11 Seriousness of impediments to trade
