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# The important role of society in anti-corruption in Vietnam

## ❖ **UNCAC:**

- An important international treaty with 183 state parties
- Specific provisions on anti-corruption in the private sector (Article 12) and participation of society in anti-corruption (Article 13).
- Many relevant provisions such as Articles 5, 21, 22 and 39

## ❖ **In Viet Nam:**

- Has not stipulated corruption in the private sector
  - The role of society in anti-corruption has been legally defined in the Law on Anti-corruption 2005

# Some limitations and causes

## - ***Some limitations:***

- ❖ the level of responsibility of the stakeholder groups in society in the fight against corruption remains limited
- ❖ The role of stakeholder groups in anti-corruption remains limited

## - ***Causes:***

- ❖ In part due to the fact that the stakeholder groups in the society have not made great efforts
  - ❖ Greatly due to the fact that state agencies do not have effective measures to enhance the role and the involvement of society in anti-corruption.
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# Recommendations

- Emphasize the "responsibility of the society"
- State agencies need to pay attention to facilitating, promoting the role and responsibility of the society in anti-corruption:
  - + Boost the propagation and dissemination of anti- corruption policies and laws; diversify forms of dissemination to suit different subjects.
  - + Enhance the detection and replication of typical examples and protect people bravely fighting against corruption; Building an anti-corruption culture in society; Integrate anti-corruption into education programs for the young.

- + Develop appropriate and effective mechanisms for the reception and handling of social reports; Specific provisions on the handling of anonymous reports
  - + Narrow the scope of the list of state secrets; ensure the right of citizens to access to information
  - + Mobilize and facilitate social organizations and all citizens to supervise the operations of public agencies;
  - + facilitate press agencies and journalists to well perform their professional responsibilities in the fight against corruption.
