





# Addressing NTMs in SPS Chapters

WTO-Plus elements on SPS issues in RTA/FTAs

- **Consultations** about a measure that may affect access to market
  - WTO-plus element: Time period to start consultations after receiving a request.
  - Examples:
    - <u>Chile-Hong Kong, China FTA</u>: within 30 days of receiving request
    - <u>China-Switzerland FTA</u>: within 60 days of receiving request.
       Within 20 days in cases of urgency
- **Border Measures** when goods are detained at the border due to issues with SPS requirements
  - WTO-plus element: Party detaining goods to notify importers why the measure was implemented. Example: China-Switzerland FTA



### **Final Remarks**

- RTA/FTAs address many types of NTMs that could potentially affect trade.
- NTMs addressed include traditional border NTMs and behind-theborder NTMs.
- The structure and content of RTA/FTAs has evolved in order to address more NTMs that could negatively impact trade.
- RTA/FTAs differ on how NTMs are addressed.
- Some RTA/FTAs are explicit in prohibiting specific NTMs.
- However, other RTA/FTAs agree on exceptions to the prohibitions in order to implement certain NTMs.
