### WHAT IT STRUCTURAL REFORM?

- Structural reform is about removing structural barriers so that people can access economic opportunity in the context of a market economy
- Structural reforms make markets work better, but they can also attain other broad policy goals such as promoting inclusion




### POLICY FRAMEWORK ON INCLUSIVE GROWTH

### 3 Recommended Approaches:

- 1. Get core structural reform functions right
- 2. Select pro-inclusion structural reforms and deepen their application
- 3. The Integrated Approach use structural reform approaches together with a range of supporting policies and programs to:
  - minimize negative impacts of structural reforms
  - address deep-seated exclusion and inequality
  - maximum the overall effectiveness of the structural reforms and the supporting policies


