APEC Vision

- "Inclusive Growth" has been the core issue in the past five years of APEC Leaders' declaration in order to ensure the benefits of growth, and globalization are felt by all levels within APEC economies.
- SMEWG therefore works to help SMEs build their capacity to innovate and engage in international trade as well as benefit local SMEs.

Income/Opportunity Disparity among Metropolitan/Sub-regional areas

- The proportion of urban population in the Asia-Pacific region increases from 41.1% in 2000 to 58.2% in 2017. (UN statistics)
- Capital regions amass more than 26% of GDP. (OECD statistics)
- Most young adults and SMEs are desperate in the local areas with lower relative income and fewer business opportunities.




Local Towns Developing Problems

Local Innovation Strengthens Economic Development




APEC Local Innovation Ecosystem Initiative: Revitalization for Inclusive Growth and Sustainable Future


