

#### **OUR MANDATE:**

To work together to improve people's health and well-being, aiming to promote trade, security, inclusive growth and development in the APEC region.





#### Key HWG Actions to Date

#### Special Discussion: Surveillance Strategies and Management of 2019nCoV (SOM1 HWG Meeting)

Knowledge exchange on respective domestic responses to COVID-19.

#### **APEC Infectious Disease Update** (SOM1 HWG Meeting)

- Discussion on key infectious disease trends in the region, including COVID-19 and increasing vaccine-preventable diseases such as polio.
- Following valuable exchange of information at SOM1 meeting in February 2020, member economies agreed this would be a standing agenda item.

#### HWG Statement on COVID-19 (released 23 March 2020)

Member economies agreed to develop a HWG Statement on COVID-19
highlighting the economic and health impacts of the virus in the region.



#### Ongoing Initiatives

#### **Best Practices in Mitigating COVID-19:**

 Beginning April 2020, the APEC Secretariat has facilitated the sharing of member economies' best practices in responding to COVID-19, including information on epidemiology, contact tracing, supply chains, etc.

#### **APEC Digital Hub for Mental Health:**

- Convened Disaster Resilience and Trauma Working Group to address the significant mental health implications of the COVID-19 pandemic and:
  - Identify the mental health needs specific to high-risk groups in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic in the APEC region;
  - Identify best practices related to using digital mental health technologies to provide mental health support to high-risk populations; and
  - Support the planning and implementation of digital mental health initiatives with an emphasis on access by high-risk populations.

- Digital Tools for Addressing Infectious Disease in the Asia-Pacific Region: Challenges and Opportunities (Chinese Taipei)
- Empowering Telehealth Solutions Across APEC (United States self-funded)

#### **APEC Health Working Group Virtual Meeting** (September 2020 – TBC)

 Malaysia to host the HWG meeting and the Life Sciences Innovation Forum, virtually.

 Malaysia to host HLM10, a joint ministerial meeting held by the HWG and the Life Sciences Innovation Forum, virtually.

#### **Digital Health Innovation:**

 Potential report on APEC Best Practices in Digital Health Innovation in Response to COVID-19, to share expertise both within the APEC region and more globally.

#### Focus on Regional Economic Impacts:

 Analyze the economic impacts of public health measures undertaken in response to the pandemic, as agreed upon in the HWG Statement on COVID-19.
