I. Introduction

• Wide Use of Online Shopping and Increasing Number of the Related Disputes.

• Average of the Disputed Amount is approximately less than 500 USD. Litigation does not work as a Realistic Tool for the Dispute Resolution.

- ADR Systems using Online has been developed in the US. ex. e-Bay
- Now ODR has been used in the various fields as an efficient tool for dispute resolution in the US.

I. Introduction

- EU has established its ODR Regulations in 2013 and has encouraged the use of ODR in the territory.
- Even in Japan, ODR has become an important issue to be discussed in the government and the Japan Federation of Bar Associations since 2019.

 Online Shopping can easily become Cross-border Transactions and Cross-border disputes can easily happen.

At the beginning stage, UN ODR Uniform Rules for B2B and B2C were tried to establish:

- 1) Three steps approach:
 - 1 Negotiation (Complains Handlings)
 - > 2 Mediation
 - > 3 Arbitration
- 2) All processes will be basically conducted by On-line based documents
- 3) Simple & Quick Process for Low Value Disputes

At the beginning stage, UN Online Arbitration Rules were tried to established:

- 1) A single arbitrator chosen by ODR Administrator
- 2) All awards shall or should be in public on web-site except private information
- 3) Substantial Enforcement by Trustmark system
- 4) World-wide Uniform Rules for the Merits!

But ... gradually ... a serious issue appeared:

Validity of the Arbitration Agreement between a Consumer and a Business Corporation

US and other economies: Of course, it's valid!

EU, Japan and other economies:

Consumer has a cancel right!

Regulations in EU (and Japan):

Since A Consumer should not be removed its right to go to Courts, the Consumer shall have a right to cancel the Pre-Dispute Arbitration Agreement

- Three Steps but No Explanation about the Third Step

EU is now establishing its own ODR platform.

But others still need uniform rules and schemes for the global ODR platform with negotiation and the third party's interventions.

APEC started its project to establish another global ODR platform. UNCITRAL and UNIDROIT assist the APRC Project on ODR.

B to C issues were avoided, at least, at the beginning stage.

APEC will not work as a provider of the ODR Platform

Instead, APEC will encourage Members to collaborate for the wide use of ODR, provide model procedural rules and encourage many ODR providers to join the APEC Collaborative Framework on ODR.

Now a document of APEC Collaborative Framework on ODR and APEC Model Procedural Rules on ODR has been approved.

It is the substantially same as the final draft on Model Procedural Rules of UNCITRAL.

APEC Collaborative Framework on ODR aims to assist Member Economies to encourage the use of ODR and potential business corporation users in the APEC region, including e-commerce market providers (platformer), to actively use ODR.

IV. ISO TC321 Project with ODR

A Project for TC321 has started in ISO as below:

Standardization in the field of "transaction assurance in e-commerce related upstream/downstream processes", including the following:

Assurance of transaction process in e-commerce (including easier access to e-platforms and e-stores);

Protection of online consumer rights including both prevention of online disputes and resolution process;

Interoperability and admissibility of inspection result data on commodity quality in cross-border e-commerce;

Assurance of e-commerce delivery to the final consumer.

IV. ISO TC321 Project with ODR

The Project for TC321 was proposed by China.

Japan tries to use this ISO standards as a Trustmark for the implementation of arbitral awards or recommendation issued in the scheme of ODR.
