
- Secretary of Agriculture signed an MOU with Secretary of Finance for an inter-agency linkage between the Customs and their Agencies

 - Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources
 - Fertilizer and Pesticides Authority
 - Philippine Coconut Authority
 - Fiber Industry Development Administration
- Agencies to exchange import and exports clearance information with Customs
 - Customs to provide hardware, connectivity and software as much as possible
- Earmarked for Dec 2007

INDUSTRY SPECIFIC PILOT PROJECT: VEHICLE


- BIS, LTO, BOC signed MOA for Processing of Imports of Motor Vehicle Parts March 2007
- Initiative was expanded to NSW for <u>import</u> and <u>exports</u> clearance for vehicle industry
- Agencies Involved:
 - Bureau of Import Service
 - Bureau of Export Trade Promotion
 - Bureau of Product Standards
 - Land Transportation Office
 - Bureau of Customs
 - Bureau of Internal Revenue
 - Bureau of Trade Related
 - Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas (Central Bank)
 - CAMPI (volunteered to join), 24 May
 - MVPMAP (volunteered to join), 24 May
- Customs to provide hardware, connectivity, software and training
- Harmonization & Standardization still ongoing
- Earmarked for 3Qtr 2007












Licensing and Constant System	Clearance
CURRENT	FUTURE
 Hardcopies of approved import permits, licenses or clearances from issuing agencies are submitted to BOC 	 Consistent with the National Single Window initiative, issuing agencies submit to BOC approved permits, licenses and clearances electronically through the Inter- agency Information Exchange Gateway (IAIEG)
 Manual validation of import permits, licenses and clearances 	 Electronic verification of permits/licenses/clearances through linkage with issuing agencies
 Utilization of import permits, licenses and clearances are verbally advised to issuing agencies 	 Permits/Licenses/Clearances are automatically written off once utilized, while the concerned issuing agency is also notified electronically




Main LCS Processes for OGA Buildup

- Entering approved licenses and clearances
- Viewing of stored licenses and clearances
- Sending of approved licenses and clearances to BOC









NSW and Project e2m

- MOU between BOC and Telecom Co.
- Project E2M is simply revolutionizing the business process of Bureau of Customs by making it mobile and wireless.
- By Short Message Service (SMS), BOC Employees, Importers, Exporters and Brokers can monitor and do their transactions via mobile phone.
- Allow stakeholders to pull necessary information from the BOC to close their transactions.



NSW and Project e2m

- Pilot implementation February 2008
- Pilot Agencies:
 - Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources
 - Bureau of Import Services
 - Sugar Regulatory Authority
 - Board of Investment
 - Bureau of Plant Industry
 - National Food Authority
 - Sugar Regulatory Authority
 - National Meat Inspection
 - Bureau of Animal Industry
 - Objective: use SMS to check authenticity and verify on real-time the license/permit issued by other government agencies
