To construct a assessment on the standards, barriers, best practices for paperless trading that would make domestic frameworks more compatible to international practice

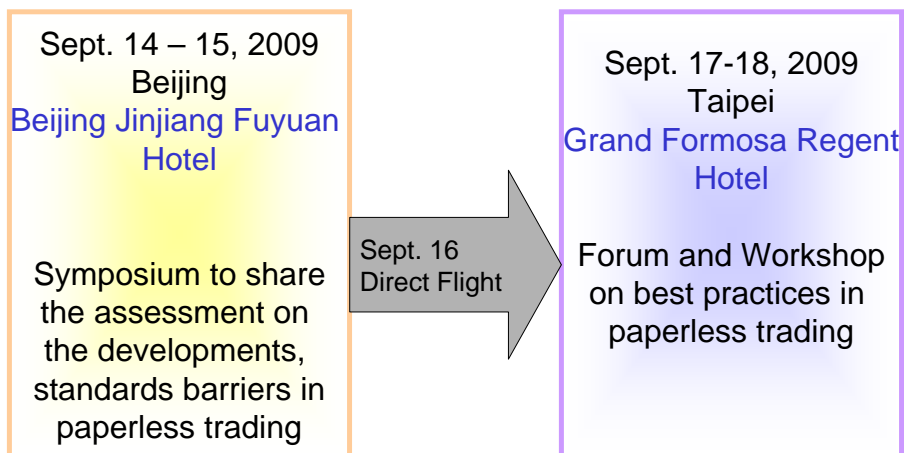

Project Implementation

- **Pre-Symposium Preparation:**
 - Field study/assessment of e-trade development status of developed/developing economies
 - Questionnaire survey and questionnaire responses analysis
- **Two-day Symposium in Beijing:** Experts with skills will deliver speeches to share their experiences and communicate with participants
- **Two-day Forum and Workshop in Taipei:** Representatives from APEC member economies will be grouped to discuss concerned issues and finally work out a best practice. Recommendation or guideline will be formulated in the last day of the symposium by all participants.
- **Post-Symposium Output:** A recommendation or guideline and final assessment report will be prepared by the hosting economy and submitted to ECSG

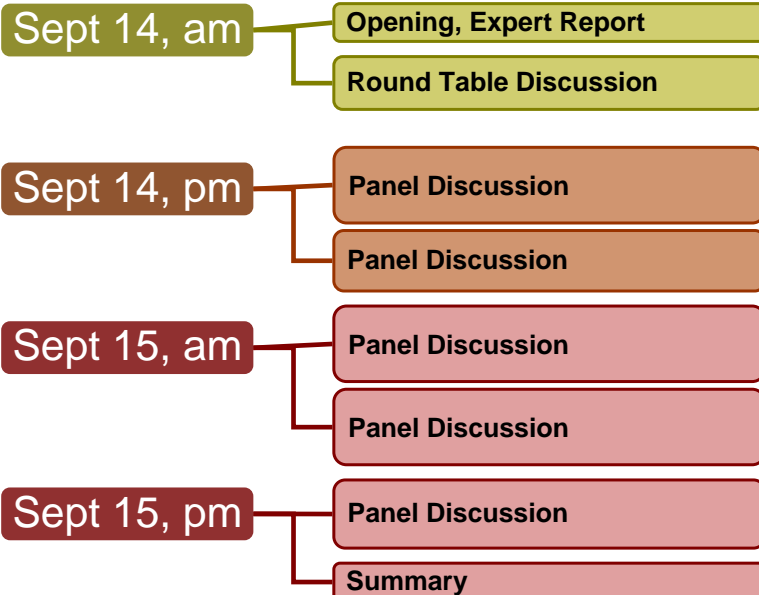

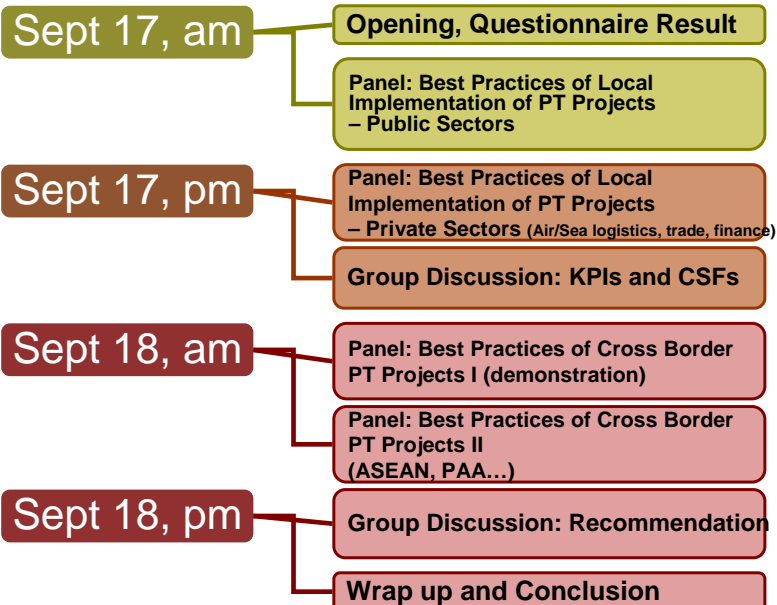

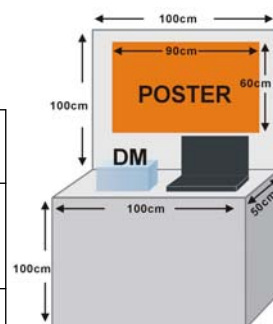
