




Procedural Measures Ministry of Interior

• Establishment of a dedicated department to confront cyber crimes – Law Enforcement "Cyber Crime and Data Networks department"; Decree 13507 for year 2002

- Confront Cyber Crimes
- Coordinate with Internet Service Providers
- Collaborate with Interpol




Procedural Measures Consumers Protection Committee




- Holding series of seminars for local councils and universities to raise awareness about safe internet and potential misuse.
- Conducting opinion surveys among users to detect dangers and determine prevention methods
- Encouraging ISPs to devise filters suitable to the community
- Coordinating between ministries of interior, justice and ISPs for monitoring, reporting and investigations


Procedural Measures National Council for Childhood & Motherhood


- Awareness and Training for prosecutors on the rights of the child (including child on line risks)

- Establishment of Ministry of State for Family and Population March 2009.
















Educational Entities


- Disseminating safety messages in educational institutes- riskssafety tips- other countries' experiences
