About the CPSC Congress creates laws, CPSC executes laws Independent agency Five commissioners 500+ employees

CPSC Mission

- Protecting the public against unreasonable risks of injury from consumer products through
 - Education
 - Safety standards activities
 - Regulation
 - Enforcement

Jurisdiction

- Jurisdiction over thousands of types of consumer products
- Excludes some types of products covered by other federal agencies
 - Automobiles and related equipment (NHTSA)
 - Food, drugs, medical devices, and cosmetics (FDA)
 - Firearms (BATF)
 - Airplanes (FAA)
 - Boats and related equipment (USCG)
 - Pesticides (EPA)

CPSC Authorizations

- 8 major authorizations :
 - Consumer Product Safety Act (CPSA)
 - Federal Hazardous Substances Act (FHSA)
 - Flammable Fabrics Act (FFA)
 - Poison Prevention Packaging Act (PPPA)
 - Refrigerator Safety Act (RSA)
 - · Virginia Graeme Baker Pool & Spa Safety Act
 - Children's Gasoline Burn Prevention Act
 - Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act (CPSIA)
- Risk-based, not precautionary
- No pre-market approval by CPSC for products
- Emphasis on working with voluntary standard organizations

Executing on CPSC's Responsibilities


CPSC has broad authority to:


- Work with industry to develop voluntary standards
- Educate consumers on the safe use of products
- Educate industry on our rules and regulations
- Issue mandatory safety standards
- Ban products where a standard is not feasible
- Recall dangerous or violative products
- Seize products that violate mandatory standards
- Seek civil and criminal penalties


