# Challenge 1

## Determining network/infrastructure continuity



Resource availability to enable quick assessment of the network can be problematic



# Challenge 2

## Supply



Alternative supply locations may be neighboring regions where demand and infrastructure greatly differs and delivery time is much longer



# Challenge 3

## Understanding the demand shift



Timely stock visibility and good intelligence will help respond to the demand shifts

- Increased demand at sites leaving the city
- Shift from retail to commercial over time

Communicate strategy to customers



# Challenge 4

## Resource



Transportation becomes more difficult.

People: have the competencies, values and behaviours that lead to loyalty, commitment and dedication to getting the task done

Fleet: more required

Operating environment: seek efficiency opportunities such as higher mass limits
