#### Back Ground Info.

- -JAXA's role in Japanese QZSS program are;
  - The development, launch of the first satellite "Michibiki"
  - The technical verification of the Michibiki system
  - Operation and promotion of QZSS <u>until system operator will</u> <u>complete the deployment of the ground control system for the</u> <u>operational system.</u>
- The responsibility of the system operation will be transferred to QSS Inc. (Quasi-Zenith Satellite System Service Inc.) in fall of 2016

### Current status of the project

- Considering transferring responsibility from JAXA to QSS, the framework for the GIT project is to be re-constructed in Japan.
- The latest discussion showed following way to forward;
  - We will continue contributing to the project as a main proposer providing experimental environment, for instance, error correction message via Michibiki satellite with cooperating other co-sponsoring economies.
  - After deciding who will take over JAXA's role on this GIT project in Japan, the updated proposal and new working structure will be reported in the coming 21st GIT meeting.
