What is the aim of the ODR work plan?

- To enable effective resolution of cross-border disputes, supporting trade and facilitating economic growth
- What kind of disputes do we mean:
 - Disputes in business to business transactions
 - Cross-border
 - Online
 - Low value



Applying a RIA framework

- Describe the status quo
- What's the problem? Is the problem the same across APEC economies? What's the magnitude of the problem?
- Identify objectives
- Identifying the full range of feasible options including nonregulatory options
- Analyse the options
- Consultation
- Conclusion and recommendations



We are defining the problem

- We are at the stage of gathering information so that we know exactly what the problem is -
 - How is each APEC economy affected?
 - How are businesses currently dealing with cross-border disputes?
 - What issues do they face?
 - What kind of businesses are affected MSMEs, goods exporters, cross-border service providers?
 - What is the magnitude of the issue?



What other information do we need?

- What types of cross-border disputes do MSMEs have?
- How do existing ODR systems work?
- What is our definition of ODR?
 - Type of technology
 - Method of dispute resolution
 - Applies to offline as well as online transactions



How can we get a practical perspective?

- We could hear from people who operate an existing ODR platform
 - what is involved
 - what issues they have had to address
- What models are there that would be useful?
 - Cross-border ODR platform?
 - Business to consumer disputes?
 - ODR Platform embedded in an E-Commerce platform
- Questions we are interested in:
 - How to meet principles of natural justice
 - Stages of ODR
 - What governance/oversight is there?
