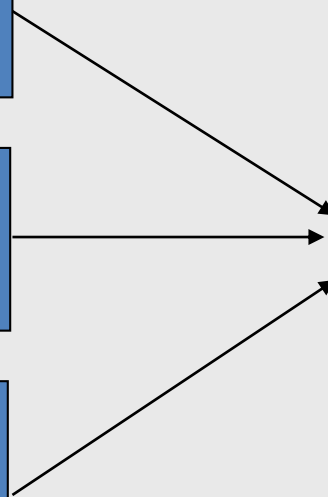

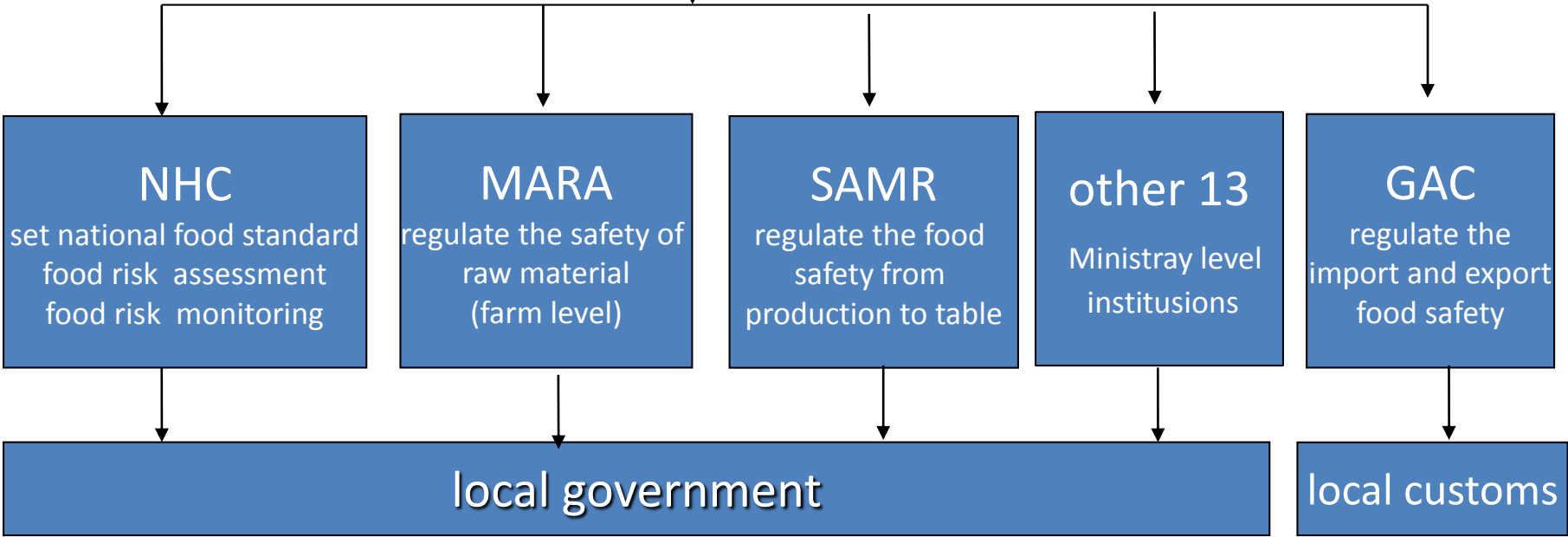
## Information sharing

## About the 3rd expert meeting



**Australia proposed the 3rd expert meeting to be held on 5-7 November in Shanghai to coincide with the 12th China International Food Safety & Quality Conference (November 7-8, 2018, in Shanghai).**

**The General Administration of Customs (GAC) agrees to cosponsor this 3rd meeting with Australia.**

**Because the reform of the institution is ongoing, after the State Council confirms the responsibility, organization, and number of staffs of the new institution (likely in July), the GAC will contact with SAMR and the Australia side to discuss the details of the 3rd meeting. We will keep in close contact with the Australia side through the Chinese Secretariat of APEC-FSCF.**

- Road-test the Framework through real life examples, demonstrating its application and utility





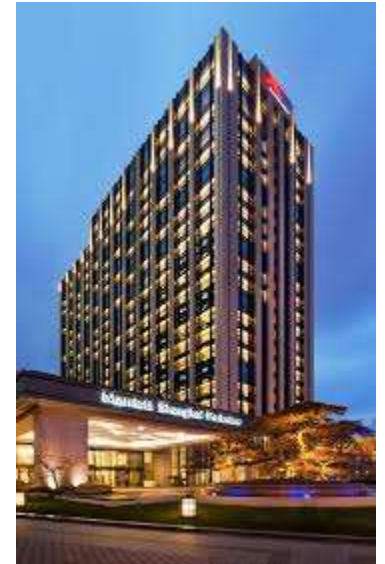
