AIMS TO INSTITUTIONALISE AND **PROVIDE ONGOING SUPPORT** TO INCREASE WOMEN'S ECONOMIC PARTICIPATION. IT WILL SUPPORT **NEW AND ONGOING INITIATIVES** RELATED TO ADVANCING WOMEN'S ECONOMIC PARTICIPATION

TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR FUNDING UNDER THIS SUB-FUND, CONCEPT NOTES MUST ADDRESS THE SUB-FUND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA, WHICH INCLUDE CO-ENDORSEMENT BY THE POLICY PARTNERSHIP ON WOMEN AND THE ECONOMY

**VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS** TO THIS SUB-FUND SINCE 2017 ARE AS FOLLOWS: AUSTRALIA: **US\$ 751,281**; CHINESE TAIPEI: **US\$ 600,000**; UNITED STATES: **US\$ 500,000**; AND NEW ZEALAND: **US\$30,376**.
