# Backgrounds: New challenges to livelihoods and economy development by natural disasters






Population at risk of exposure was increased due to accelerating urbanization and climate change (Flood in the Philippines, 2009)

# Current Challenges - Population at risk of El Niño for example: Droughts in APEC region






### **Backgrounds – "New Normal"**

#### **Home elevation after Superstorm Sandy in New Jersey**




