- Over £300 million of suspected stolen assets were restrained in affected states following IACCC support
- In Asia, a senior public official was found guilty of corruption offences. The IACCC supplied evidence to support the prosecution
- In Africa, a property worth GBP 260,000 was restrained following the receipt of significant intelligence from the IACCC
- In Asia, a senior public official was charged with corruption offences following the receipt of significant intelligence from the IACCC
- In Africa, 23 suspects were arrested, including 5 PEPs, following the receipt of significant intelligence from the IACCC

What is the Women Against Transnational Corruption Hub (WATCH)?

- An international network formed by professional women working in the anti-corruption sphere
- Hosted by the IACCC in London

Guiding aims

- Connecting professional women working in this sphere across all continents
- Providing a platform where members can enquire about investigative and judicial processes, as well as advice on career development

Actions

- Set up of regionally focussed messaging groups.
- The WATCH team is currently building a website and it plans to host an online resource library with anti-corruption material.
- Gathering data on gender breakdown of teams the IACCC interacts with.
