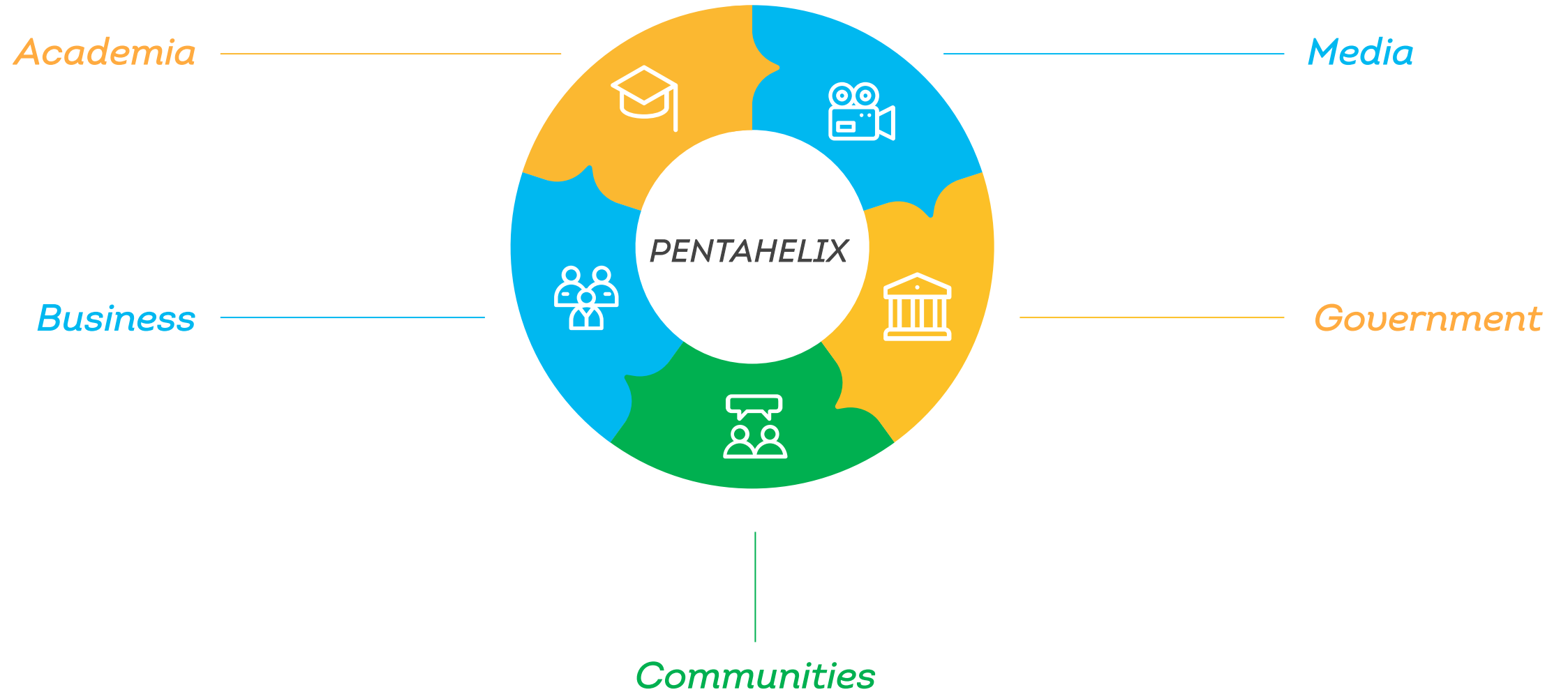

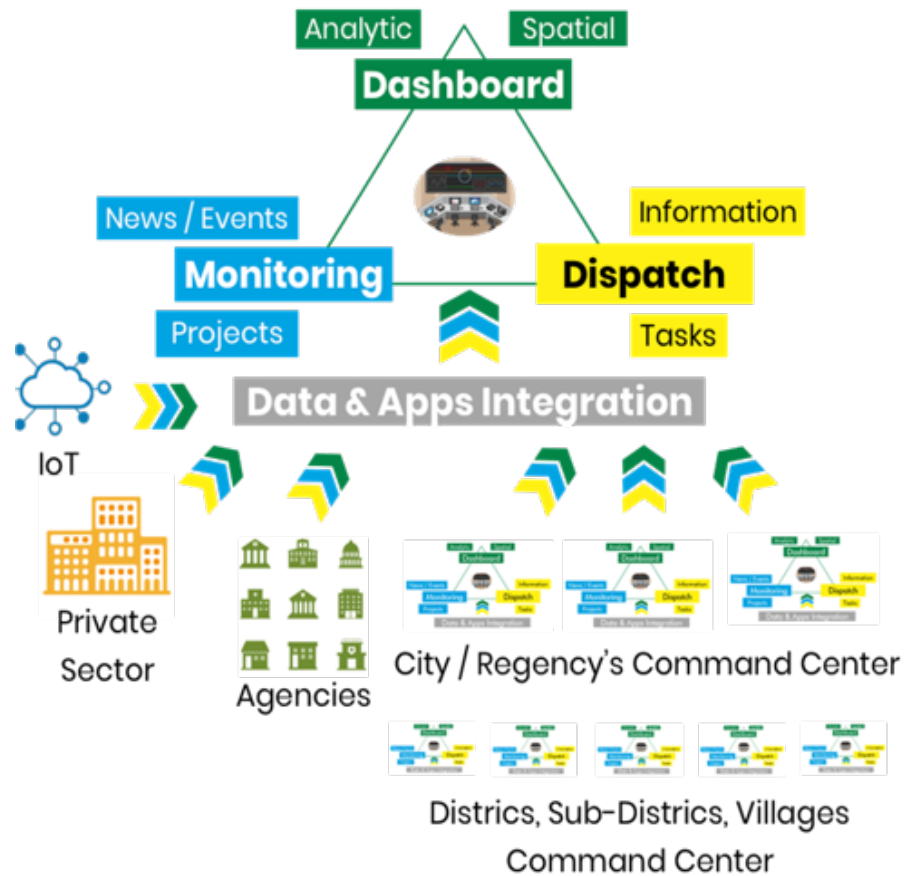

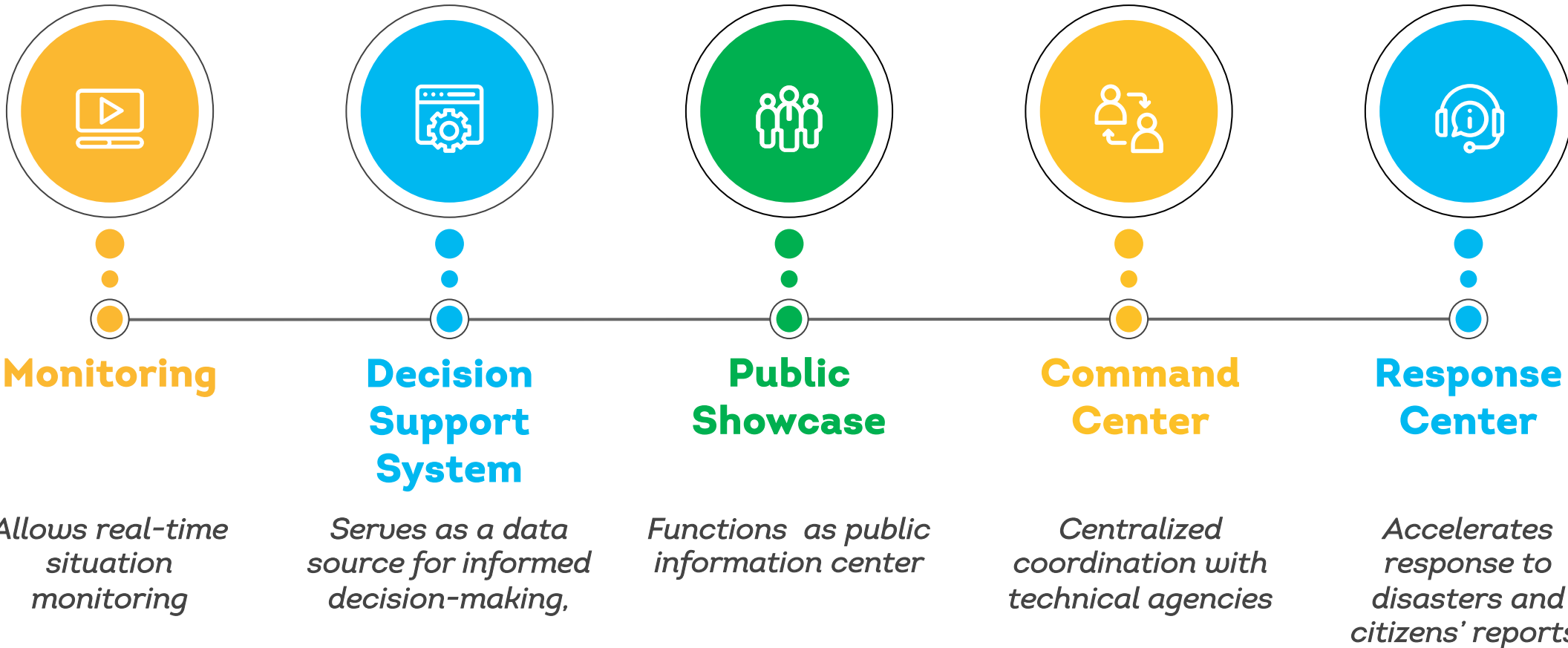

JABAR COMMAND CENTER AS A DEDICATED COVID-19 RESPONSE CENTER

Provincial Government
of West Java



Immediately after West Java declared a COVID-19 emergency status, *Governor Ridwan Kamil dedicated Jabar Command Center as the West Java Information and Coordination Center (Pikobar)*

Jabar Command Center has become a real-time data center and media analytics – continuously monitored for 24 hours supported by applications and digital tools developed by Jabar Digital Service.



One day after West Java declared a COVID-19 emergency status, Governor Ridwan Kamil launched the West Java COVID-19 Information and Coordination Center (Pikobar) *website*. 16 days later, we launched the Pikobar *mobile application*.

LEVEL 1. INFRASTRUCTURE



Rumps up on internet infrastructure and procurement with BAKTI in over 400 villages.

LEVEL 2. DIGITAL LITERACY



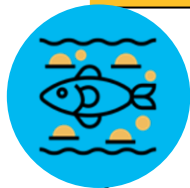
Providing digital literacy training from partners and community including Patriot Desa and local IT volunteers.

LEVEL 3. TALESIA/E-COMMERCE



Work with various partners including Tokopedia to increase the potential resource in the villages, already implemented in 25 areas across West Java.

LEVEL 4. FISHERY



Collaborating with eFishery, we deploy IoT to optimise fishery cultivation. The program have been implemented in 2 regencies

LEVEL 4. AGRICULTURE



Collaborating with Habibi Garden, we deploy IoT to increase agricultural production, 2 villages in 2 regencies have earned notable benefits

LEVEL 4. TELEHEALTH



Collaborating with Docta, telemedicine is deployed in villages with minimum medical healthcare workers. 6 villages in Garut received this service.

LEVEL 4. EDUCATION



Collaborating with Edubox, we complement education facilities using smart routers for offline access, implemented in 4 villages at 3 regencies.

LEVEL 4. MULTIMEDIA



We invited 10 villages and communities in West Java to join multimedia training in creative content and content creator.

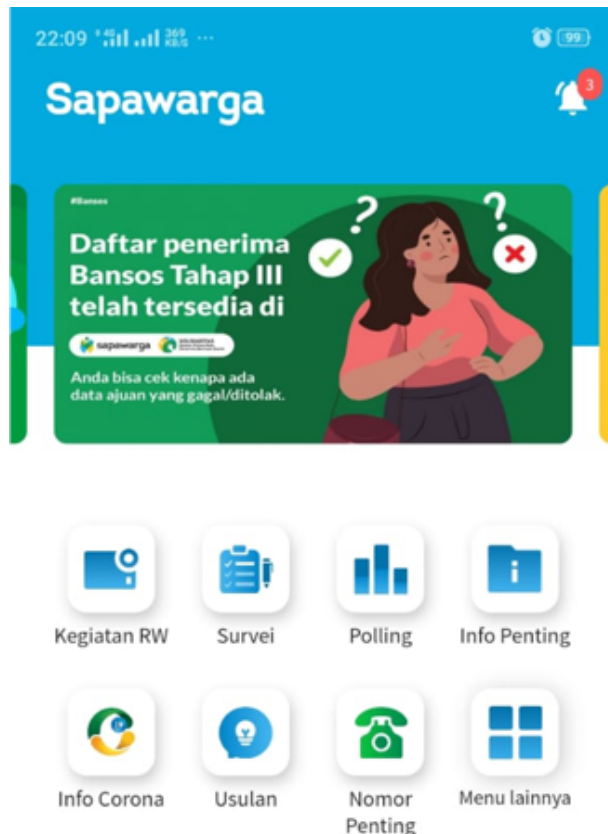


MOBILE ENGLISH COURSE

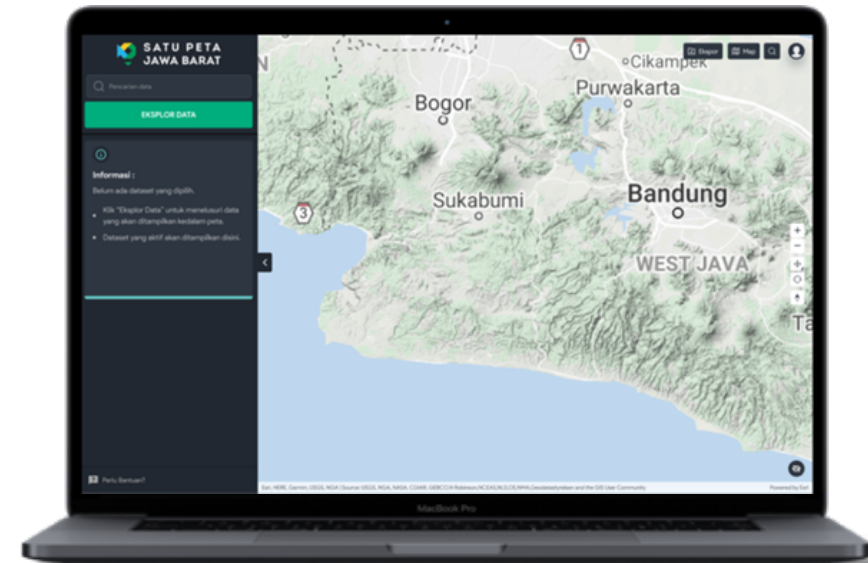
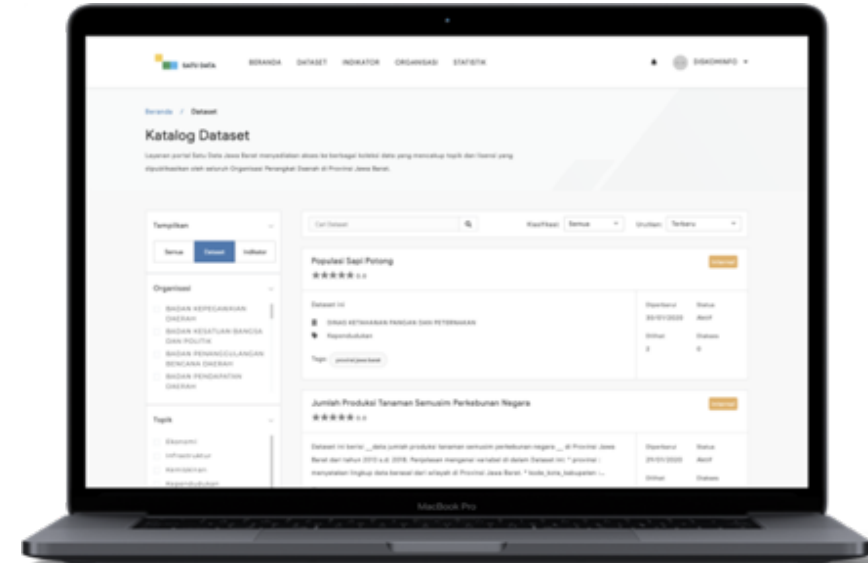
