~ 3rd Workshop (3 August*) – Interoperability and Data Security for Single Windows ~

Our first workshop focused on privately operated trade platforms "digitizing" trade documents. However, in order to fully "digitalize" trade procedures at customs and ports of entry, these platforms need to work seamlessly with public systems and single windows in respective economies. In addition, international interoperability between these domestic systems is essential.

Furthermore, trade procedures have historically placed a lot of emphasis on the originality of documents. It will be critical to ensure the reliability and originality of transmitted data for cooperation between systems.

In this workshop, which is the third of a series of four, we will introduce initiatives and technologies to connect a single window with trade platforms and with other single windows. We will, then, discuss how to ensure reliability of data and, thereby, to facilitate interoperability between systems.
