## APEC template for voluntary self-identification of inefficient fossil fuel subsidy measures

On November 2021, APEC Ministers welcomed the options (outlined in the CTI Annex on Addressing Inefficient Fossil Fuel Subsidies in APEC), that member economies could take to pursue the voluntary standstill on inefficient fossil fuel subsidies. In order to contribute to the fulfilment of this tasking, this template will facilitate the voluntary self-identification of inefficient fossil fuel subsidy measures. <sup>1</sup>
