





Future-proofing APEC amid an increasingly uncertain environment

Things to prioritize in the short-term:

- Ramp up vaccination uptakes to guard against virus resurgence and mutations
- Bring down inflation to mitigate cost of living and poverty. Manage expectations, communicate clearly policy changes.
- Provide well-targeted fiscal support to vulnerable households. Increase revenue and improve fiscal position.
- Avoid the implementation of exports restrictions/prohibitions on essential goods (e.g. food, medicines, fuel)

Toward a sustainability and inclusivity agenda: Things to attain in the medium to long-term

- Strengthen the APEC region's connectivity
- Protect the environment and achieve sustainability goals
- Increase productivity
- Address digital divide and disparity in access to technology and automation skills
- Ensure women's full and equal participation in the economy






