Objective of the Survey


- Understand firms' operating environments, specifically in understanding the supply chain challenges post-pandemic.

Synopsis of Findings


• Largely in line with the 5 chokepoints identified in the SCFAPIII framework.

Inefficiencies encountered when utilizing digital platforms for trade documentation.




Infrastructure development to support robust multi-modal connectivity and logistics network:




Data flows and cross-border payments to support increasingly digitalised supply chains:
