GRP to Lifecycle of Mandatory SNI

Adoption and Evaluation

Regulation is adopted after taken all consideration into account. Transition time is available for producers to comply to the regulation. Evaluation of the regulation is conducted regularly.

Notification

Regulator notifies the draft of the regulation to TBT Committee through BSN as Indonesia TBT WTO Notification Body and Enquiry Point

Regulation Drafting

Regulator starts the process of drafting the regulation following the good regulatory practices principles



Identification

Regulator identifies the necessity to draft a technical regulation and the available SNI(s) to achieve its legitimate objective

Analysis (RIA)

Regulator conducts a Regulatory Impact Assessment to asses the necessity of such technical regulation

Program of Technical Regulations

Regulator informs BSN on which SNI(s) they wish to regulate as mandatory in order to achieve its legitimate objective





Procedure for Development of Technical Regulation



Identification

Regulator, such as the Ministry, identifies the need for a technical regulation, its legitimate objective, and SNI(s) being referred



Drafting and Comment

Documents being drafted, taken into account inputs and comments from all relevant stakeholders (other gov agencies, industry, consumer)



Notification

Should necessary, such as when it is considered that the regulation will impact global trade, a notification will be made to TBT WTO through BSN



PNRT

When the regulation incorporate SNI as its reference, regulator should submits its intention to BSN through Program of Technical Regulation (PNRT).



Harmonization

Draft is going through harmonization procedures, led by Ministry of Law and Human Rights, taken consideration from all stakeholders.



Publication

After thorough consideration and consultation, the regulation is published in the official gazette of Indonesia





Draft Regulation

Regulator submits formal request to notify the draft of the regulation to TBT WTO Committee through BSN as Indonesia TBT WTO Notification Body










Indonesia's Committee on TBT

Working Groups

RESPONSIBILITY

WG responsible for providing comments and inputs to other members' notification and technical regulations that can potentially become technical barriers for Indonesia's product

MEMBERSHIP

WG consist of technical elements and experts from key ministries, regulators, business actors, and associations

REGULAR MEETING

Meetings are conducted as necessary, usually once a month depending on the issues that are important to be discussed

OUTPUT

WG aims to provide inputs and comments to other WTO members technical regulations.

WG also report to Committee of TBT regarding issues that are necessary to be raised to STC or bilateral meeting





Weekly Notification

Generate data from ePing

BSN as Enquiry Point regularly monitors ePing and compiles them into a weekly matrix

Publication of Matrix

The weekly matrix is published in BSN website, consist of the notification title, brief description, and the trade value

WG Meetings

Based on the matrix, WG(s) are informed on what issues are important to discuss in a meeting

Enquiry sent


Based on the output of WG meeting, enquiry is sent to relevant EP on relevant notifications





e-Ping Participation

BSN, as Notification Body and Enquiry Point has actively encouraged officer from relevant ministries, experts, academician, and companies to register to e-Ping platform provided by TBT WTO Committee. As a result, in 2021, Indonesia is listed as top 5 members with high ePing participation.







e-Ping Participation

Indonesia's participation in e-Ping platform is dominantly filled with government, followed by industry, associations and representative from university as seen in the chart below





Challenges and Opportunities

Information Access


Some of our stakeholders, especially SMES are having limited access to TBT issues

Coordination

Dynamic changes in responsible official from relevant authorities impacts the coordination process

Transparency Awareness

A few numbers of regulators are not aware yet of transparency obligation to TBT WTO



ePing

ePing is extremely helpful to provide relevant information as long as internet is available

Forum Utilisation

Strengthen the Committee and WG utilization that ultimately will strengthen Indonesia's position in TBT

Dissemination

Through online platform, dissemination information is now easier to conduct than before
