About APSN

The APSN mandate was reviewed by all APSN Council Members and approved at the 47th APEC Transportation Working Group meeting in 2018:

The mandate of the APSN is to promote economically and environmentally sustainable ports by strengthening cooperation, developing best practices and guidelines, enhancing supply chain effectiveness, building capacity and stimulating information and personnel exchange among port and port-related industries and services in the Asia Pacific region with the goal of the liberalization and facilitation of trade and investment to achieve common prosperity of the APEC member economies. (Article 3 of the APSN Constitution)

What is GPAS

The GPAS program is a green evaluation system for ports in the APEC region by the APEC Port Services Network (APSN). It constitutes a critical part of APSN's ongoing efforts to promote the sustainable development of the APEC port industry as a whole. Since the official launch of GPAS in 2016, 53 ports or related entities from 10 APEC economies have won the title of APEC Port Services Network Green Port.

Objectives

The objective of the GPAS is to encourage green and sustainable development in port and port-related industries. In particular, it aims to provide a clear roadmap to develop green port plans, to build a platform for best practices sharing, to raise the profile of ports to promote overall competitiveness, and to improve their capacity for sustainable development.


